**Ivan Pyatiletov (1902-1944)** Guards Corporal of the 2nd Guards of the Taman Division, rifleman of the first Guards Regiment



My great-great-grandfather Ivan Pyatiletov participated in the assault on Sapun Mountain. In 1944, he died in the battles for the Crimea. For courage and bravery, he was awarded the Order of the Red Star, but he didn't work it out. A few years ago, a special search group from the Arkhangelsk region sent an award to the relatives of the deceased soldier. After 73 years, the award found its hero in the person of his descendants. It was a significant event for our family! I am proud that my great-great-grandfather was one of those who brought the long-awaited moment of victory closer!
